WHAT YOU NEED...

1. Physicals – Every athlete is required to have a physical before they can participate in practice or play in games. No athlete will be allowed to start practice without a physical dated on or before July 21, 2008.

2. Application Form – Every athlete is required to fill out the Application form and have the Insurance Waiver properly signed. It is included as part of this brochure.

3. Football Participation FEE – Athletes must pay their Participation Fee prior to their first practice. See the Fee section in this flyer for additional information.

EQUIPMENT DAY

FIRST DAY OF PRACTICE

Official Practice begins on Monday, July 28, 2008. Practices will be held on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday (Possibly some Saturdays). The Head Coach or Cheerleading sponsor will determine all practice times.

FEES

Costs per player: \$75.00.

Costs for each additional player (from the same family): \$40.00.

Late Fees: Payments after July 19, 2008 should include a \$15.00 late fee per athlete.

Sign-up Deadline: August 9, 2008..

FOOTBALL CAMP \$15.00

This years conditioning camp will begin July 21, 2008 through July 25, 2008. Camp will begin at 6 PM, each camper will receive a JFL T-shirt. This year, the camp will be ran by the Pawnee High School football coaching staff.

FUNDRAISING OPTIONS
